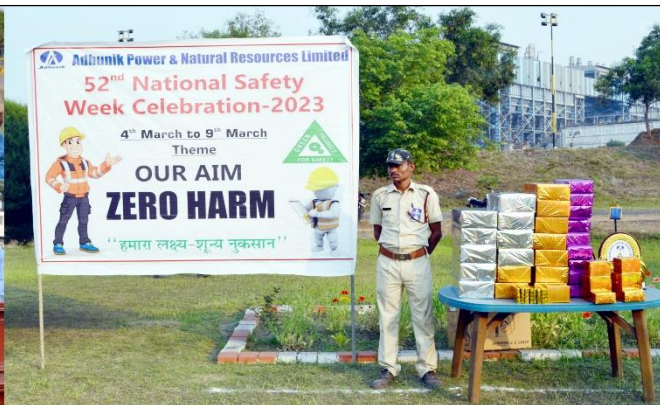
Safety is a way of life
